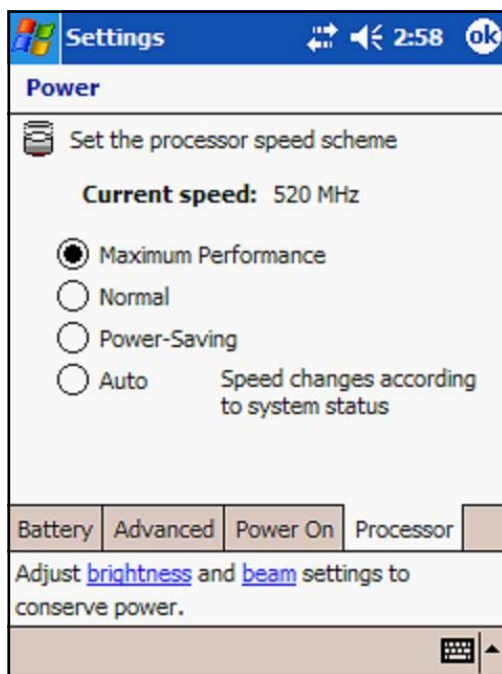


# Performance Optimization on the Pocket PC

## On the Pocket PC:

- Tap: Start->Settings->System tab->Memory icon->Running Programs tab. Click on program you want to close then click Stop button.
- Soft reset the device – *will also stop PocketDairy.*
- Explore device folders and delete any files not needed (*for example RecordingX.wav where 'X' is a number*)
- Start->Settings->System tab->Remove Programs icon. Click on the program no longer wanted from the list of Programs in Storage Memory and click the 'Remove' button. (*NOTE: do not remove 'Microsoft .NET CF 2.0, 'Microsoft SQL Mobile 2005', or 'PocketDairy 7.x.x'.*)
- If PocketDairy version is 7.9 or newer, use the 'Database On Storage Card' feature (Main menu->Prefs menu).
- Last resort – hard reset the device and re-install PocketDairy device components; re-sync with PCDART.
- Start->Settings->System tab->Power icon->Processor tab



*Some devices may not have a 'Processor' tab. For example, the Asus MyPal has Start->Settings-> Asus Settings (icon)->Mode (tab) with 'Run Mode' settings of Turbo Mode, Standard Mode, Power Saving Mode, and Automatic Mode. These generally correspond with what you see on the left.*

- **ActiveSync** options for Calendar, Contacts, Tasks, Favorites, Pocket Access, Inbox, Notes, Files, and AvantGo synchronizing causes associated enlargement of some 'secret' files on the device (peek in the device \Databases folder).
- Open ActiveSync on the desktop, Tools->Options and un-check everything.
- If using ActiveSync 3.6 or 3.7, upgrade to 3.8.
- If using ActiveSync 4.0 or 4.1, upgrade to 4.2.
- Both should be available on the PCDART CD.
